

Valid Photo ID

- This can be a driver's license, state-issued ID, passport, or military ID.
- If you're a student, you can bring your school ID and a copy of your birth certificate.



Current Address

- The first time you come in, we'll need proof of your current address. This can be a paycheck stub, utility bill, copy of your housing lease, or school enrollment form.
- Each following donation, we'll just ask you to confirm your current address. No proof needed!
- If you move, you'll have to provide proof of your address again.

There are a few items you have to bring with you each time you wish to donate.

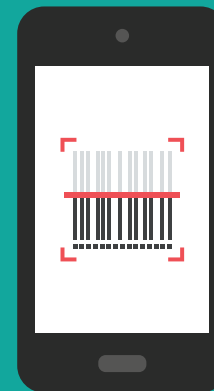
Know Your Social Security Number

- Each time you donate, we'll ask for your social security number.
- If you know your social security number, you can provide it verbally. Or, you can provide proof of your social security number. Proof includes your social security card, a W-2 form or paycheck stub with your full name. If you're not a US citizen, you may provide proof of your individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN).
- If you provide physical proof, the name on your photo ID must match EXACTLY with the name on your proof of social security number.



QuickPass Barcode (Current donors)

- Instead of filling out your health questionnaire at the Spectrum Plasma center, fill it out ahead of time on your phone the day you donate!
- You can find the questionnaire on Spectrum Plasma's Donor Resources page or by visiting www.aboquickpass.com/welcome?cust=NUP
- After completing the questionnaire, be sure to either print out or take a screenshot of the barcode on your smartphone.
- Your barcode expires at midnight on the day you complete the questionnaire.
